

Swivel Bar Stool Sports Antique Tractor Seat

You'll like the looks and feel of these new swivel bar stools that are fitted with real antique tractor seats painted in "tractor colors".

"Farmer Boy" seats are made by Riverside Metal Craft, Inc., of Hawkinsville, Ga. The company buys the antique tractor seats from various equipment sellers and adds a baked-on, powder-coated finish. The seats mount on steel swivel plates fastened on top of a 4-legged, glossy black steel frame. The seats are available in three colors - IH/Massey red, Deere green, or Ford blue.

"They're comfortable and everyone loves how they look," says a company spokesman. "Many customers tell us they remember having a tractor with a seat like this, or having a grandpa who owned one."

Three models are available in heights of 18, 24 and 30 in. They sell for \$125 each plus \$10 S&H.

"Our new outdoor cat feeder keeps dogs and birds from stealing your cat's food. Birds can get inside it, but if they do they're trapped," says Dick Preston, Brock, Sask., about the patent pending "Kitty Kitchen" which can also be used alone as a bird trap.



It consists of 16 ga. galvanized, 1-in. sq. steel mesh over a steel frame that's 4 ft. in diameter and 2 ft. high. There's a hinged hatch on top for placing food or bait inside the cage, and a tapered tunnel on one side that gets smaller as it reaches the center of the cage. The tunnel is too small for most dogs, but cats can enter and exit it any time

they want. Birds can walk through the tunnel but once they're inside the cage they're trapped because they can't figure how to get out - they just follow the outside of the cage.

"It keeps dogs and birds - especially Magpies - from wasting cat food," says Preston. "Birds can get in, but it will be their last supper. Anchor pins are provided to keep aggressive dogs from moving the cage around."

Snow Rake "Slices" Snow Off Roof

Cleaning snow and ice off a roof is a bad job, but sometimes you've just got to do it.


To make the chore easier and less damaging to shingles, the A.C. Hedstrom Co. has developed a new-style roof cleaner that works like a big cheese slicer.

It consists of a 2-ft. wide by 9-in. deep aluminum slicer head that weighs just 5 lbs. It's fitted with a 10-ft. length of slippery plastic that trails behind the slicer. When you push upward on the slicer, snow slides quickly down the plastic and off the roof. When you pull downward, the snow also ends up on the plastic and slides down behind the slicer.

Standing on the ground, you can clean 2 ft. of snow off a 12 by 24-ft. garage in approximately 10 minutes with much less risk of damaging shingles, according to the company.

Nail Starter Fits Any Hammer Head

You can drive a nail with one hand while holding up whatever's being nailed with this new nail starter that straps onto any hammer head.

The simple new device fits over the top of the hammer and is held in place with a single nylon strap. It's fitted with a small spring on one side that holds the nail. You just drive the nail with the side of the hammer to get it started, and then twist the hammer to release it and drive the nail the rest of the way.
