Now you can carry your complete medical history, including any special instructions regarding allergies or medications, with you at all times on a plastic card you carry in your purse or billfold.

In case of an accident or other emergency, when seconds count, doctors or emergency room personnel only have to grab this card to get your complete medical history. It has been reduced to microfilm and sealed inside a plastic card which travels with you wherever you go to help answer such questions as — Blood type? Diabetic? Heart condition? Allergic to penicillin or other drugs?


Old Wall Phone Back In Style

Can You Prove It's Your Property?

If your shop tools, machinery or other equipment is stolen, there's no assurance it can be recovered — if there are no permanent serial or other identification numbers. Stolen property that can't be positively identified can't be used as evidence against a suspected burglar.

Federal, state and county agencies concerned with the transportation of stolen property across state lines receive a directory which enables them to quickly locate these ID numbers.

Doe, of David City, Neb., your number would be NB02503061D. The NB is for Nebraska, "025" is for Butler County, and 0306 indicates you were the 306th farmer participating in the program whose last name begins with D.

Regardless of which type of code or mark you use, it's recommended that you place it on more than one place on most equipment, including some out-of-way location known only to you.
