You'll like this "no electric" wind-powered pond aerating windmill from American Eagle that generates pressurized air to keep ponds fresh.

Made in the U.S., it has a 4-legged tower for more stability. A bellows pump generates air in the pond to combat algae and aquatic weeds. It also prevents winter kill of fish and improves water quality.

3-Pt. Hitch Stabilizer

"It puts an end to 3-pt. hitch sway," says Ken Klingler, Klingler Mfg., about his new 3-pt. hitch stabilizer for IH 656 to 1586 tractors.

Built from heavy 3/4 by 6-in. plate steel, the hitch blocks bolt into place with no modification of tractor. Hitch arms slide on the outside of the vertically-mounted plates. Spacer bolts hold stabilizer blocks in the correct position for either Cat. II or Cat. III hitches. No holes to drill.

"Without these blocks, IH hitches can sway as much as 3 in. Once installed, hitch arms hold steady as a rock. They won't move even with the heaviest implements. We have had these units out for over 16 years and the people who have them are truly satisfied. There is a money-back guarantee."

The hitch stabilizer blocks sell for \$145 per set plus shipping. Some models require narrower hole spacing so specify tractor model when ordering.

Klingler also makes crop deflector plates that attach to stabilizer bottom plates to protect tall row crops from damage. They sell for \$15 a set. Dealer inquiries welcome.

V-Top trap catches starlings, sparrows. up to 100 per day

600 hundred starlings can eat ONE TON of animal feed a month. Very costly. Now you can catch up to 100 birds a day with this all metal V-Top trap. It's 5'x 5'x 6'.

Birds land on the top and then drop down through the narrow V opening. If a desirable bird is trapped, it can be released unharmed.

The first birds are attracted by food, like old bakery goods, and water. Once the first few birds go into the trap, they become the bait... it's a decoy trap.

The trap breaks down into 15 welded wire interlocking panels; 4 heavy steel corner posts; and the V cone on top. Wt. 125 lbs. Sells for \$304 plus shipping .
