

See-Through Bird House Mounts On Window

Your kids will love this new see-through birdhouse that attaches with suction cups to any glass window.

It has three solid sides but the back side, which is up against the window, is clear. You can watch the entire life cycle of a bird family from building the nest to the hatching of eggs to the first flight of the fledgling birds.

The 4 by 4 by 8-in. birdhouse is made of pine with an acrylic back window. It has a 1 1/2-in. dia. entrance hole which can be narrowed down with a 1 1/4-in. adaptor.

Easy-To-Use Campfire Grill

If you do a lot of camping, or you just like to cook over an open fire occasionally, you'll like this simple cooking grill that moves up and down on a single metal stake.

"We've made and sold more than 800 of these grills," says farmer-inventor Floyd Graber of Shipshewana, Ind.

The grills are finished with nickel chrome plating, which is safe for foods cooked over a fire. The cooking surface of grill is 15 by 22 in. It slides up and down on a steel stake and needs no pins or set bolts to hold it in place. The weight of the grill binds on the stake. It's strong enough to hold coffee pots and pans, and you can



swing it away from the fire as needed without taking it off the stake.

Take Hot Showers Anywhere

You can take a hot shower anywhere if you have a car, truck or tractor handy to hook up to this new shower kit.

It consists of a heat exchanger unit that's 13-in. long by 4-in. in dia. and weighs less than 4 lbs. It mounts on a bracket anywhere under the hood (on the firewall, for example) and plumbs into the hot water line. Once installed, the unit will provide hot water any time the engine is warmed up and running.

It uses a 3.3 gpm/35 psi pump to draw water from a tank, bucket, river, or lake. The water is first filtered, then passed through the heat exchanger and out through a hand-held shower hose to provide continuous hot water at up to 105° F at 1 1/2 gpm.

Suitable for use on virtually all 4, 6 and 8-cyl. gas and diesel engines. Installs easily



in a couple hours, says the Australian manufacturer who's interested in establishing a distributor network in North America.

High-Volume Meat Mixer

You can mix up to 100 lbs. of meat at a time and make sausage fast with this new automatic meat mixer that's powered by a 1/2 hp electric motor.

The "Lazy Jim" meat mixer consists of a plastic tub equipped with an agitator with three paddles that's belt-driven off the motor. The tub mounts inside a steel frame that rides on four caster wheels.

"It plugs into any household outlet and lets you mix 100 lbs. of meat in only about 5 to 7 minutes," says inventor Jim Kowalchuk. "It's lightweight and is easy to move around your kitchen. The tub can be easily removed for cleanup by pulling a pin and removing the agitator. When not in use the unit can be stored in most pantries. It's 15 in. wide, 31 in. long, and 35 in. high."

Easy Way To Pull On Boots, Shoes

You can pull your shoes or boots on or off without bending or stooping with this new grabbing tool called the Shoe Valet.

The 2-ft. long unit has rubber-lined gripping jaws on one end. You simply pull up on the handle until the jaws grip the backs of your shoes or boots, then you pull them on. A two-pronged boot jack on back can be used to push footwear off by the heels.

Bug Suit Keeps Insects Away

You can keep all biting, probing, and stinging insects away with this new lightweight bug suit that's been proven from the rain forests of Costa Rica to the north woods of Canada, according to the designer.

The Bug Taboo suit is made of a tightly woven micro-mesh polyester material originally used for filtering air in submarines, says Dan Hunsinger of NetWorks Enterprises.

Because it's designed to billow out when worn, it keeps mosquitoes off the skin, and because it assumes the temperature of the air instead of the body, ticks, flies and gnats won't bother you either, Hunsinger says. The suit has a slight negative electrostatic charge which also helps reduce the number of insects attracted to you, he adds.

The entire suit weighs only 8 oz. but is strong, tear-resistant and cleans up easily. Comes with attached hood and head net. Available in six adult, three children's sizes. Sells for \$59.95.

Pistol Grip Garden Tool Helper

You can get more leverage and greatly reduce fatigue with this new pistol-type grip for rakes, shovels, hoes, shop brooms, etc.

The 7 1/2-in. long "Get-a-Grip" handle slides onto tool handles from 7/8 to 1 1/4-in. in dia. You simply loosen two T-knobs, position the gripper where it feels comfortable, then tighten it down.
