Ionizing the water greatly increases its ability to penetrate into the cloth fabric and lift out dirt particles.

"We don't promise cleaner clothes than you get with normal detergents, but equal results at tremendous savings," says company representative Don Gilbert. "You'll still need to pretreat stains and grease spots just as you would with normal detergent. We sometimes put in an extra teaspoon or tablespoon of soap for an extra boost on light colored clothes because there are no whitening agents in the discs. We never use anything but the discs on dark clothes.

"The discs also prevent static cling and the need to rinse clothes. They're environmentally friendly and also eliminate irritants that cause allergic skin reactions from chemical additives, which is important to persons who have sensitive skin.

"Water is the perfect solvent for cleaning clothes except that the surface tension



 the electrical attraction between molecules - prevents it from penetrating the fibers of the fabric. The laundry discs solve the problem by making water more penetrating without chemicals.
